In conjunction with the CTA/NEA agreement, the Board of Trustees has authorized two sabbatical leaves for the 2015/2016 academic year. You are eligible to apply for the leave if you meet the following criteria.

- Minimum of six consecutive years' service.
- No previous granting of a sabbatical leave within at least a six-year period.
- No unauthorized absence from the District within the six consecutive years preceding the granting of any sabbatical leave.

If you desire to seek the granting of a sabbatical leave, please complete the attached application and submit it to the President's Office at your college no later than November 1, 2014. The campus committee will then review all applications and make their recommendations to the District no later than November 15, 2014.

- Coursework to be completed (if applicable)

Please be sure to attach the following to the application:

• A typed description of the proposed Sabbatical Leave program, with identified outcomes. Include your goals, any travel plans, and how the project specifically supports the mission of the College.

Award Criteria

All applications meeting the SBCCD Sabbatical Leave Policy's purpose will be ranked in order of relative importance based on the following criteria:

Proposals will be rated on scale of 1 -10 (10 = highest)

- Research design/project specificity
- Value to College/students/applicant
- SBCCD Values

All Sabbatical Leave Proposals must be submitted to the Office of the President by November 1, 2014.

If granted Sabbatical Leave, I agree to abide by the terms of SBCCD's sabbatical Leave Policy, and to submit a final report during the first semester of my return.
